






## Learning to Count

There are many different notes in music. These different notes tell you how long to hold down a key.

QUARTER NOTE		Hold the key down as you count "1"
TWO EIGHTH NOTES		Play the key twice as you count "1 +"
HALF NOTE		Hold the key down as you count "1 - 2"
DOTTED HALF NOTE		Hold the key down as you count "1 - 2 - 3"
WHOLE NOTE		Hold the key down as you count "1 - 2 - 3 - 4"

## Learning C, D, E

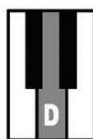
The **WHITE KEYS** on the piano keyboard are named after the first seven letters in the alphabet: **A B C D E F G** over and over.

The **BLACK KEYS** on the piano keyboard are in groups of **TWOs** and **THREEs**.

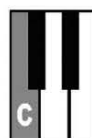
On your piano, find all of the “**BLACK TWOs**.” Then find all of the “**BLACK THREEs**.”

We use the **BLACK KEYS** to help us find the **WHITE KEYS**. Today you will learn the names of the **WHITE KEYS** around the **BLACK TWOs**.

**D** is in the middle of the **BLACK TWOs**:



**C** is to the left of the **BLACK TWOs**:



**E** is to the right of the **BLACK TWOs**:



As fast as you can, find all of the **Ds** on your piano keyboard. Then find all of the **Cs**; then find all of the **Es**.

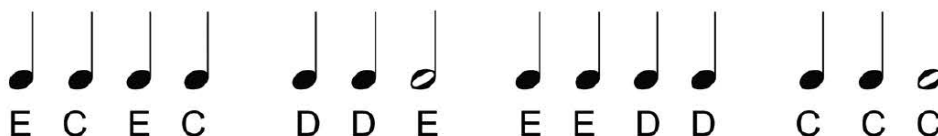
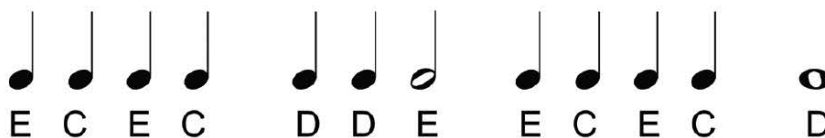

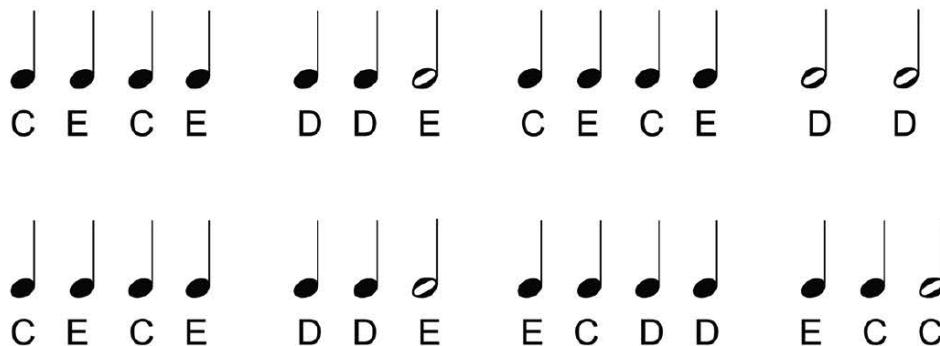
## Green Toad Boogie
